Staff Report (10 minutes)

- TA Update -
 - a. 3 new TAs hired within the last few weeks - fully employed with TAs at this time
 - b. SED planning and delivery is going smoothly and incorporated in multiple areas
 - c. TAs are being observed and supported in their professional growth
- Operations Team Update
 - a. ADA compliant Ramp installed in front of bungalows 20 & 21 (Learning Lab)
 - b. Concrete ramp installed at entrance to garden and blacktop
 - c. Currently replacing floors in hallways of main building
 - d. Continuing conversation regarding Return to Campus (Staff Advisory Committee updates weekly)
 - i. In conjunction with Instructional Team: Mapping out which population of students to prioritize returning to school and creating a safety plan for each contingency
- Lead Teacher Updates-
 - a. TK-5: Teachers are working to collect data for progress reports. This looks different at different grade levels, may be in small group or one on one, may be during group time or otherwise. Appreciate templates, resources and time to work on reports, but still feeling the weight of completing testing and reports, especially with so much screen time during the day
 - b. 2nd Grade: Mrs. Rogers back from Maternity Leave (3 week transition between Ms. Jones and Mrs. Rogers)
