CWC-Hollywood ASP Enrichment Class Permission Slip – Fall 2017

Registration: The below permission slip is the registration form for enrichment classes, and must be returned to Gloria Bigelow by Tuesday September 5th. Because the number of participants in each class is limited, selection will be based on a lottery system if there are more interested applicants than spots available. Students will automatically be placed on a waiting list, if not offered a spot in a class or if permission slips are received after the due date. Your child's spot in a class may be forfeited, if payment for the class is not received by September 8th. Students on the waiting list may be admitted later if spots become available. There will be a limited number of scholarships per class for students who qualify for the free lunch program. A separate lottery will be held for those spots. You will be notified, through e-mail if your child has a spot in an enrichment activity, been placed on a wait list or has received a scholarship. All classes have a 10-student minimum and a 15-student maximum unless otherwise noted.

Due Dates: Registration forms are due by **9/5**
Payment is due in full on Tuesday **9/8**

Activity Fee: Price varies depending on class – see below.

Policies: Students who are participating in enrichment classes are a part of the regular after-school program. Therefore, a separate Monthly ASP form is due every month. Please note on your form, which day your child is enrolled in enrichments If your child is staying after their enrichment class ends, the regular daily fee for ASP is required.
